

## **UNIVERSITY PLACEMENT SEROLOGY SCREENING PROCESS FOR STUDENTS**

### **FIRST APPOINTMENT**

- 1 Make an appointment with a doctor at either Gawler Place Medical Practice or University Health Practice for student screening. You can do this online or by phone.

**IMPORTANT: Please bring to this appointment proof and history of all past immunisations you have had since childhood including any travel vaccines.**

Your first appointment is a non-claimable appointment and a fee of \$50 will apply on the day to see the doctor.

- 2 On this first visit you will be asked to see Clinical Labs onsite to have your blood taken. **PLEASE NOTE THAT IT IS IMPORTANT** that you bring in proof of past immunisations including travel vaccinations as each screening that you have done at pathology will be a cost to you.

**Price will depend on how many items you need done hence the importance of bringing to the appointment your past history. If you have had all items done in the past then the doctor can give you clearance without any more appointments or vaccinations or cost to you.**

- 3 If you do have bloods taken then you will also need to make an appointment at the front desk at the end of this first appointment to come back in to see the doctor for a second appointment to discuss results from the pathology and also to have any vaccinations you require.

### **SECOND APPOINTMENT**

- 1 At this appointment you will see the doctor for **RESULTS of the BLOOD SCREENING** and also **have any vaccines that you may require.**
- 2 The doctor will see you first to discuss your results and also to do a general health check. If vaccinations are required you will see the nurse and have them done on this day.

**Please note:** On your first visit you will be required to pay the fee of \$50 for the first visit to the doctor as this is a non-claimable consultation. There are pathology costs for any screening if any bloods are taken. You will be posted an invoice for payment of the pathology cost.

On your second visit you will be required to pay for any vaccines you may need to have done on this day. If you do not have medical insurance cover you will be required to pay for the doctor's visit as well on this day.
